Biographical data

Suresh Canagarajah is the Evan Pugh University Professor of English, Applied Linguistics, and Asian Studies at Pennsylvania State University. He teaches courses in Global Englishes, Multilingual Academic Writing, Sociolinguistics, and Decolonization Studies. He was formerly the editor of the *TESOL Quarterly* and the President of the American Association of Applied Linguistics.

An overview of educational aspirations, cultural dispositions, and identity trajectories among Japanese mixed-marriage families in Singapore. The talk highlights how these are shaped by local and transnational ideologies and socio-cultural discourses.

Glenn Toh has written book chapters and full-length monographs published by major academic publishers on issues relating to language, ideology, power, and identity. He continues to teach graduate courses on thesis writing and academic publishing after four decades in education, besides continuing his research work on academic literacies and writer subjectivities, and researcher reflexivity.
